

Principles of Excellence (PoE)

On April 27, 2012, the White House established the Principles of Excellence to ensure Service
members, Veterans, spouses, and other family members have the information they need to make
informed decisions concerning their well-earned Federal military and Veterans' educational benefits.

DoD MOU and Instruction

- The Department of Defense Instruction (DoDI) 1322.25 establishes the Department of Defense
 Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) program.
- The DoD MOU and DoDI were put together to protect DoD Service member students, including:
 - Voluntary education policy
 - States eligibility criteria for tuition assistance (TA)
 - o A signed Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with DoD to provide educational programs and receive TA
 - o Institutionalizes within DoD the Principles of Excellence in support of Executive Order 13607 (2012)

MOU Program Overview



So ... what is a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)?

- An administrative program: defined by DoDI 1322.25
- An agreement: between an Educational Institution and the Department of Defense
 - Covers all Service Tuition Assistance for Active-Duty Service members
- An Information System:
 - Public facing webpage: https://dodmou.com/
 - Provides access for Institutional MOUs
 - Provides information and news
 - Backend data system:
 - Facilitates MOU approval process
 - Captures Educational Institution data
 - Provides a communication link
 - Via internal notifications and emails




MOU: Administration, an Agreement and an IT System


MOU Program Snapshot




MOU Program Snapshot FY17-23

MOU Modernization Overview



Modernization Effort – WHY?

- Current MOU IT system is from 2014
- System last updated in 2019
- Based on an older technology development
 - Hard to update and maintain
 - Impacts overall Operational Stability
 - Some lingering data structure issues
 - o Usability (user-experience) lacking
- System reviews conducted FY20 and FY21
- Preliminary design work and planning completed FY21



It's time to modernize the system ... we want your input!

MOU Institution System Feedback



Unsolicited:

- "System navigation and overall layout is not intuitive."
- "The MOU site is routinely down or returns page errors."
- "This system is unnecessarily complicated."
- "The help features don't always help, and information is buried in different sections."
- "For some things, I always end up having to contact the Support Team for help."

Solicited:

- Via "Listening Sessions"
- Top 25 Educational Institutions (based on FY20 TA enrollment data)
- Added "targets of opportunity"

MOU System Feedback, cont.



Listening Sessions

- Phase 1 (Planning): August 2022
- Phase 2 (Discovery): August 2022 December 2022
 - Individual Institution listening sessions
- Phase 3 (Processing): December 2022 current
 - Data consolidation
 - o Feedback
- Phase 4 (Outcomes): January 2023 July 2023
 - Developing elements and requirements for "MOU 2.0"
 - Implementing changes
 - Testing and Prototype feedback

Listening Sessions "Buckets"

Communication Issues

- Emails (confirmations and smart sends)
- Internal messages (unread)

Design / Basic Functionality

- Allow system to accept 0.5 credit
- Clearer "signing" page
- Export Institution data
- Rethink the "pulldown" menus

Help Features

- Compliance Tutorial is too long
- Need "quick charts" for all the rules
- Clearer definition of data tables and usage

Policy Issues

- 30-day account sign-in
- 90-day rate waivers
- Modify Additional Locations

System Issues / Integrations

- Consolidated / Combined DoD VolEd system
 - MOU, Services, etc.

Workload Issues

- Too much time / clicks to update Rates
- Too much time for Program Rates
- Limited automation:
 - Upload Programs
 - Upload Rates
 - Upload Fees & Expenses

Our findings confirm known pain points and system issues

MOU Modernization Vision & Objectives



What we are planning:

Overall System Vision:

- Intentional & collaborative design and development
- Increased functionality and transparency
- Intuitive and user-friendly interface

Specific System Objectives:

- More Automation
- Better User Experience
- Enhanced System Integration(s)
- Transparent Workflows and Better Data Visibility
- Data Refinements
- Administrative "clean-up"



What we are planning:

- More Automation
 - Reduce redundant human actions
 - More opportunities to upload data vice manually enter it
 - Add error-checking routines & features; for example:
 - Logic based: immediately check for wrong data types or values that are not possible
 - o Mechanical: physical test accuracy of phone numbers, emails, websites, etc.
 - New Features: Copy & Paste (or replicate) = fewer manual data entry points
 - How this helps the user:
 - o Reduced manual input:
 - Upload Rates, Fee, Expenses via file
 - Few rate forms / inputs via a Rates table
 - Consolidation of Program Rates like Location Groups
 - System checks for data errors:
 - For example: tuition rate = \$195,195 per credit hour ... clearly a typo

Targets: Workload, System Design, Overall Functionality





What we are planning:

- Better User Experience
 - Modern and standardized website
 - More intuitive dashboard and interface
 - Robust communications
 - Pushes: News / Announcements from VolEd
 - Notifications: system or data changes
 - User Prompting: based on time or other changes
 - How this helps the user:
 - More effective and efficient communications
 - Targeted emails (vice "all" system shotgun approach)
 - Additional system notifications based on user preferences
 - More functional dashboard with useful information
 - Data focused dashboard with interactive components



Targets: Communications, Overall Functionality




What we are planning:

- Enhanced System Integration
 - Modernized Automated Program Interfaces (APIs) & data-exchanges with other systems
 - Better flow of authoritative TA data to the Service TA system
 - Reduces burden on Institutions to keep Rates and other data updated in multiple systems
 - Issue & Focus:
 - The DoD MOU system is the authoritative source for TA data (Rates & Fees)
 - However, the systems are not as integrated as they could or should be
 - Ideal data flow / situation:
 - Institutions update the MOU system
 - Service systems update routinely with data from the MOU system
 - End state: Institutions do not have to update Rates/Fees in multiple DoD systems



What we are planning:


- Transparent Workflows and Better Data Visibility
 - MOU Approval "tracker"
 - Relevant & useful data
 - Completion progress markers
 - How this helps the user:
 - Clear visibility into where an MOU is in the approval process






What we are planning (Integrated Dashboard):

Example: Integrated dashboard and visualizations that combine external data (ED, VA, TA, other) with internal system and Institution data – to provide better insights and a more holistic perspective








What we are planning:

- Data Refinements: Structure
 - Data elements
 - Addition of relevant data for Service members
 - o Removal of other data elements no longer needed or not used
 - Data analytics
 - Visualizations of the data: historical Rates, Fees, etc.
 - Examples:
 - Tuition Rates: 160 active types
 - o Fees: over 9,000 active Fees in the system
 - o CIP Codes: of those that exist, many are still 2010 (vice 2020)






What we are planning:

- Administrative "house-cleaning"
 - Standardized nomenclature and structures, for example:
 - "Educational Institution" vs "Institution" vs "School"
 - Rate and Rate Types
 - Fees and Fee Types
 - "UnEarned TA"
 - Program Modality:
 - In-Person
 - Distance Education
 - Hybrid
 - Knowledge Management
 - o FAQs, User Guide, Compliance Tutorial, Help Features, News, Resources, Learn More, etc.

Targets: Communications, Help Features, System Useability

The current system will be in place for the near-term


MOU Modernization Way Ahead

- FY23: MOU 1.0 Sustainment and MOU 2.0 Development
 - Compliance Health Checks
 - MOU 1.0 Stabilization
 - MOU 1.1 System enhancements in preparation for potential policy changes
 - MOU 2.0 Prototype (end of FY)
- FY24: MOU 2.0 Implementation/Testing
- FY25: MOU 2.0 Migration
